All entries will be judged using the following criteria:

## Stage 1

All entry material has been received by the deadline and all the entry criteria have been met in full.

## Stage 2

All entry material is marked against the judging criteria. Judges will use their area of expertise to judge entries.

## Stage 3

Judges establish the accolade awarded. The entry is judged on the basis of the material provided

There will be **NO** limit to the Gold, Silver and Bronze Awards awarded per category.

## Terms and Conditions

1. Only plants@work Ltd members can enter the competition.
2. Each contract is judged upon its own merit
3. The same project may be entered in as many categories as appropriate.
4. Previous award winners are not permitted to re-enter the same site in the same category for any of the plants@work Awards for up to 3 years
5. Entry must be in the form of a complete Official Entry Form and Project Description
6. Entries received without a completed entry form may be deemed invalid and not submitted to the awards judging panel.
7. plants@work reserves the right to withdraw an entry from the judging process at any time if the entry does not meet the criteria or the entry is deemed inappropriate for any reason. plants@work decision is final. No refunds will be made under any circumstances.
8. The entrants will not know who the judges are until judging is completed.
9. The judges will be unaware of the entrant's name at the time of judging.
10. When access is required to a contract the entrant must arrange that the judges can visit the contract during normal working hours and arrange relevant supervision once inside the building.
11. Where photos/slides are required these will become the property of plants@work Ltd. State on your photo's/slides the name of the contract and number them in the order you wish the judges to view them.
12. DO NOT identify yourself or your company. If you are entering the same contract in more than 1 category please submit a separate set of photos/slides for each entry. Digital photos should be sent in on a CD-Rom or via email
13. All entry materials become the property of plants@work Ltd, please make duplicates of prints and negatives before submitting your entry, as plants@work cannot guarantee returning of the artwork.
14. plants@work Ltd has the right to publish all entries in plants@work publications and on the plants@work website and use them in promotional materials for plants@work and other publications promoting the interior landscaping industry.
15. The digital files must be at a resolution of at least 300 dpi and print at A4 size.

17. Entry forms must be completed and submitted by deadline, the entry fee must accompany the entry, and there will be **no refunds**.
